MSS works in Surajpur, Surguja, Korba, Korba, Dhamtari, Jangir- Champa, Bilaspur and Kabeerdham of Chhattisgarh state, covering 350 villages with more than three lakhs population. The broad spectrum of intervention domain include- promotion of Gram Sabha for self-

EDUCATION

Education for children with disability:-

Education is the most important part of everyone's life as it is the lifelong learning, a sense of dignity and self-worth and social participation. Education is the wise, hopeful & respectful cultivation of learning undertaken in the belief that all should have the chance to share in life.

Children with disabilities face multiple form of discrimination which leads to their exclusion from society and school. Attitudes towards children with disabilities as well as a lack of resources to accommodate them, compound the challenges they face in accessing education. While lack of excess to school is an issue, an equal consent is the

inability of the education system to ensure quality education for CWDs.

While the convention on the Rights of the child (CRC) & the education for all frame work aim to meet the learning needs of all children & youth, the convention on the rights of Person with disabilities (CRPD) recalls those obligations and further specifies that "States part shall take all necessary measure to ensure the full enjoyment by the CWDs of all human rights & fundamental freedom on an equal basis with other children", and "ensure & inclusive education system at all levels and lifelong learning" (Article 7 & 24).

Children with Disabilities have a Right to Education:-

The Persons with disabilities (equal opportunities, protection of rights & full participation) Act, 1995.

- Every CWD shall have the Rights to free education till the age of 18 years in integrated school or special schools.
- Appropriate transportation, removal of architectural barriers and restructuring of modification in the examination system shall be ensured for the benefit of CWD.
- CWD shall have the right to free books, scholarships, uniform & other learning materials.
- Special school for CWD shall be equipped with vocational training facilities.
- Non-formal education shall be promoted for CWD.

Margdarshak Seva Sansthan is trying to develop education system for the children with disability so that they will develop in inclusive environment and have a better possible start in life. According to age group education system has been classified such as

- Pre-education: Aanganwadi centre is the early first stage for inclusive education of children.
- Primary education: - It is a second stage towards education.
- Secondary and higher secondary: - it is the third stage of education where children will come to know about the importance of education in life, learn the value of education, gain qualification and skills for their livelihood.
- Non-formal education: - This education system is for the children with disability who are not willing to come school out



of their fear or unable to move towards school due to Physical disability. For this home based education system are developed which come under non-formal education system.

- Lifelong learning: - Person with disability has access of lifelong learning opportunities. There is no age limit for educational learning, they can learn it anytime as education is important in every once life.

Children club and Children parliament:-

The purpose of Children club model is to improve inclusive education systems progressively towards quality standards, addressing all elements that influence the well-being and rights of children with disabilities as participator and learner. Teaching while improving other school functions in the process. Quality standards should make it possible for all children to access school, survive from grade to grade and complete the cycle on time; they should also provide an enriched educational experience through which students can thrive, develop and achieve their full potential. To this end, CFS models are concerned with harnessing the full involvement and support of all parties

in a position to facilitate children's right to a quality education. These parties, or 'duty bearers', include parents, communities, teachers, school heads, education planners and civil society groups, as well as local and national governments and their external partners. Their involvement enables schools and education systems to provide the conditions and resources necessary for achieving the quality standards CFS models envision. Children club is form with the participation of student, teacher of a particular school which teaches the children to behave equal with the Children with disabilities. Equality is the main focus behind the formation of children club

Works of Children club:-

1. After formation of the inclusive children club, meeting with teachers and headmaster about Child safeguarding act and Policy 2016.
2. Than encourages children with disabilities participation in each and every activity of school like: Rangoli competition, drawing competition, song completion and sports competition.
3. Provide a variety of stimulating and exciting play opportunities for the Children with disabilities in a group situation.
4. We are encourage the children with disabilities to be independent, to experiment, to be creative and to develop self discipline and acceptable behavior Children with disabilities have the opportunity to enhance their learning through a wide variety of activities and to promote physical development.
5. Organize some indoor or outdoor games for inclusive children club.
6. Making them learn a new language or subject out of curriculum.
7. Doing group social activities with them.



Children parliament:-

Children's Parliament is an inclusive and democratic body- of the children, for the children and by the children. Children's Parliament is a federation that addresses local, State, national and international forums towards affecting their own lives and those of their peers. Each parliament comprises 30 children aged 6 to 18. District-level parliaments elect representatives of the State Parliament. The parliaments elect their own 'Prime Minister,' 'Vice-Prime Minister,' 'Speaker' and 'Ministers. Organized several block level child parliament meeting at lakhanpur, surajpur, Ramanujnagar, Pondariya, Dabhara, Nagari and premnagar blocks. In that meeting discussed about selection procedure of children for children parliament at cluster level (each staff have 10-

15 villages together they form 1 cluster). Then discuss about role and responsibility of children parliament representative. As well as function & structure of children parliament. The main objective of children parliament is creating an environment amongst children about inclusion of children with disabilities in education, social, political, cultural. According to child rights and protection act and policy children should aware about child rights, child protection, child trafficking, domestic violence against child, children drop out, Children With Disabilities enrollment and child labor. Children parliament should address the child rights policy local, state, national and international forums towards affecting their own lives.





Children parliament annual meet:-

On 14 November 2019 organized children parliament annual meet at Ramanujnagar block on behalf of children day. Around 200 children participated in the program. Organized Cultural program like group dancing, singing and speech about children day took place among the

children. Saw video on what children parliament is, how it functions and how to strengthen it. T-shirt also distributed to children. Cash prize was presented to those whose performance was good.



MODEL AAGAWADI:-

Model Aanganwadi primarily focus on the vulnerable and malnourished children and children with disabilities they provide supplementary nutrition to children below the age of six and nursing in inclusive education, nutrition and hygiene of children with disabilities those who are 0-6 years of age group in Aanganwadi. An Aanganwadi is a rural health care center for mothers and children run by the Integrated Child Development Services

(ICDS). The Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) scheme is one of the flagship programmes of the government of India and represents one of the world's largest and unique programmes for early childhood care and development. Each CBR worker visit model aanganwadi once on their field work day. Teaches the children, play with them learning game; provide knowledge and importance about nutrition to the children parents.





ENVIRONMENT:-

The environment is the sum of the total of the elements factors and condition in the surroundings which may have an impact on the development, action or survival of an organism or group of organism, such as us human beings. It also been defined as “external surroundings and conditions which directly affects the living



organism. Deforestation is the process of cutting down the tree for various purposes such as to make home necessary item like door, window and burn the wood for cooking purpose. Deforestation should be control to build a better environment.



FOREST RIGHT ACT 2006 CFR/IFR:-

The Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 is a result of the protracted struggle by the marginal and tribal communities of our country to assert their rights over the forestland over which they were traditionally dependent. The implementation of the Forest Rights Act,

2006 on 1st Jan 2008, has finally paved the way to undo the ‘historic injustice’ done to the tribal’s and other forest dwellers. Individual forest right act 2006, people were aware about their rights of forest, land, wild food, conservation of natural resources through awareness meeting on CFR/FRA/IFR





AWARENESS MEETING ON FOREST CONSERVATION:-

Awareness amongst community people regarding forest conservation, water pollution & conservation, tree plantation, nursery, wild food and wild life conservation, and natural resources also aware about CFR/FRA/PESA, biodiversity and ecosystem. It also engage rural population

living in the community to build positive attitude and behaviors to reduce threats to biodiversity, with this develop positive attitude for conservation and initiate action towards sustainable solution for biodiversity conservation.



STATE LEVEL MEETING ON TRIBAL PEOPLE:-

State level meeting has been organized about social, political, economical and cultural and security development of tribal community because tribal people have better control and management of forest conservation and natural resources will improve their livelihoods and

incomes. Tribal people have rights for implementation of FRA policy. PESA will minimize exploitation of tribal population as they will be able to control and manage money lending, consumption and sale of liquor and also village markets.

CLUSTER AND BLOCK LEVEL MEETING:-

Cluster and block level meeting have been organized in khadgaon, bhandardehi and koriya blocks regarding conservation of forest, natural resources, water conservation, conservation of wild food and wild life for illegal cutting of natural resources like wood,

flowers, herbs and biodiversity. It also acknowledges community people the important of forest conservation to create better livelihood out of it with better income opportunities.



WATER CONSERVATION AWARENESS:-

Water pollution is one of the measure cause of livelihood because after the industrial revolution it has a very bad effects on livelihood and specially water, whatever things came from mines like dust and poison gas are polluting water and also effecting river. For that reason it was harmful to human being, animal and marine

animals. Because of this polluted water people are suffering from various skin diseases. Polluted water is also causing extinction of animals and affecting the agriculture. In order to protect water pollution, water conservation awareness meeting done among the individual community members.



COMPENSATORY A FORESTATION FUND MANAGEMENT AND PLANNING AUTHORITY (CAMPA):-

Adani group of industries in parsakete block of sarguja district of Chhattisgarh for coverage area of land effecting the environment as well as natural resources. For

that reason conserving the natural resources and wildlife such as identified 16 grampanchayat of khadgaon block of koriya district. Therefore state government decided



4500 acre coverage land of farmers will forestry through CAMPA fund. Campa(Compensatory a forestation Fund Management and planning Authority). By the support of local leaders organized awareness meeting with PRI member's

regarding forestry of villages through CAMPA. In that meeting all PRI members were against the CAMPA because they said it should implement in adani group of industries coverage areas.



TREE PLANTATION:-

Planting a tree is a lifelong investment. How well this investment grows depends on the type of tree selected and the planting location, the care provided during planting and the follow-up care after planting. Getting your new tree off to a healthy start will help the tree mature to its full size and ensures it will provide environmental, economic and social benefits throughout its lifetime. Organize Tree

plantation program at Kataroli jungle. In that program Planning before planting can help ensure that the right tree is planted in the right place. Proper tree selection like: Mango, Guava, Azadirachta indica, Indian gooseberry and Aegle marmelos because it create a good environment with green, clean and healthy.





LIVELIHOOD:-

Livelihood program for inclusive poor & marginalized people in the society for economic development of people with disabilities through various Income generation program (IGPs) like: Mushroom production, General merchant, fishing, cycle store, animal husbandry etc. through agro & non agro based skill development training such as: Mushroom production, vermin compost, organic farming and tailoring for linkages with microenterprises. IGP are provided to people with disability individually by seeing their



capability in which field they are strong and they can have a better growth opportunity in their life. It seen IGP are working successfully with better output out of these. Livelihood is the way that helps in earning money. Livelihood is necessary for people with disability as it help them to earn enough income to lead dignified lives and contribute economical strength to their family and community. Livelihood training provided by MSS to people with disability, SHG and farmer group.



SHG (SELF-HELP GROUP):-

Inclusive SHG is a group formed by the community women and women with disabilities, which has specific number of members like 10 to 15. In such a group the poorest women with disabilities would come together for emergency, social reasons, economic support to each other have ease of conversation, social interaction and economic interaction. SHG is a micro-enterprise covering all aspects of self-employment, organization of the rural poor into self Help groups and their capacity building, planning of activity clusters, infrastructure build up, technology, credit and marketing. Self-Help Group refers to self-governed, peer controlled, informal group of people with same socio-economic background and having a desire to collectively perform common purposes. Here

poor people voluntarily come together to save whatever amount they can save conveniently out of their earnings, to mutually agree to contribute to a common fund and to lend to the members for meeting their productive and emergent needs. A SHG is an informal association to enhance the member's financial security as primary focus and other common interest of members such as area development, awareness, motivation, leadership, training and associating in other social inter-mediation programmers for the benefit of the entire community. SHGs meeting with poor and marginalized women and women with disabilities about reformation of SHGs group, planning, monitoring process and how to we go fast to reach our goal. Some SHGs members were told about how SHGs help for



them like: if someone or any women with disability wants to need money for treatment, marriage or other purpose of business SHGs will help them. Those SHGs really wants to need financial support through Income generation program like: Mushroom production, tailoring, general merchant and fishing they make their plan. Some SHGs members were expressed their plan like what they want to do like: chicken cultivation, prepare leaf plates, make candles and smoke stick. Even those SHGs were going under I.G.P for mushroom production. MSS will provide mushroom seeds as soon as possible because it's seasonal business. Even discussed about how to SHGs members were. People with disability under the umbrella of SHGs carrying out income generation activities for improving their household's economic

conditions.

This year organized several meetings about strengthening and formation women group included women with disabilities about their livelihood, IGP, regular saving, monthly meeting and maintaining registers. Also gave information about various govt. schemes, women group leadership and oriented them about how to fight against their rights, liberty, dignity, gender discrimination and reservation for their entire women group in society. Strengthen about socio-economic-political and cultural participation in their present condition in society. Aware them about group strengthening and group dynamic to help them for team work by group formation.



FPO (FARMER PRODUCER ORGANIZATION):-

Farmer producer organized is to mobilizing farmers into member-owned producer organizations, or Farmer producer organized is to enhance production, productivity and profitability of agriculturists, especially small farmers in the society. The purpose of FPOs is to develop sustainable agriculture sector by promoting and supporting member-owned Producer Organizations that enable farmers to enhance productivity through efficient, cost-effective and sustainable resource use and realize higher returns for their produce, through collective action supported by the government

and fruitful collaboration with academia, research agencies, civil society and the private sector. Margdarshak SevaSansthan is working for the development of disable people in 6 districts. MSS have formed 7 producer groups at Surajpur district and in the process of expanding the number of producer group. Each producer group should contain minimum 50 members including both people with and without disable. Through training and verification of their identity MSS identify the capability of producer group and provide them with fund. With these funds they try to develop



a small scale industry or producer group for their sustainable growth. Benefit of formation these producer groups are giving employment to those who are unemployed and willing to

learn. For securing the future of the member involved in the group (which is also the vision of MSS).



ADVOCACY WITH PRI MEMBERS & GOVT. OFFICERS AT PANCHAYAT LEVEL:-

Panchayati Raj is a system of rural local self-government. It has been established by the acts of the state legislature to build democracy at the grass root level. It is entrusted with rural development and was constitutional. Continuously, mobilize and motivated PRI members about disabilities inclusion in social, political, economical participation of people with disabilities in local bodies. Formation and strengthening CBR committees at panchayat level. CBR committees consists of 2 DPOs members, 2 PRI members, 2 ANMs workers, 2

parents, 2 teachers, 2 AWDs, 2 SHGs members for promote people with disabilities with different issue related certification, pension, employment, livelihood, reservation, scholarship, assistive device, enrollment of people with disabilities at panchayat level. Because through CBR committee people with disabilities directly consult with CBR committee team members for different issue. Outcome: through advocacy with PRI members 2 people with disabilities has been selected ward members of local bodies.





ADVOCACY WITH PRI MEMBERS AT BLOCK LEVEL:-

Motivated PRI leaders at block level regarding actively participation of PRIs leaders about policy implementation of RPWDs act and policy 2017 for people with disabilities like: certification, pension, linkages with various govt. schemes like: PAY, Unique ID, Adhar card etc. also discuss about strengthening and promotion CBR committee for formation at panchayat level as well as role and responsibility of CBR committee representative disabilities accessibility facilities in local bodies

as well as public places, Even discussed about 2% of reservation should be implementation in local bodies as members for people with disabilities. Outcomes: Through the manifesto of national congress committee published an order regarding people with disabilities pension increased up to 1500 rupees and it will directly transfer to people with disabilities saving account and it should be implementation as soon as possible.



CBR TRAINING FOR PROJECT STAFF:-

This year organized Staff training on CBR and People with Disabilities Act 2017 and policy. In this training trained them about MANREGA and its various schemes as well as inclusive participation in MGNREGA, the process of implementation of RPWDs act in community level through various awareness meeting, individual responsibilities, and contribution per organization, dedication, improvement of presentation skill, knowledge, attitude, behavior

changes, self confidence, and self respect. Total 7 training has been organized about implementation procedure of MANREGA various schemes. Total 225 staff members were participated included (Male-148 , female-77). Training provided this year for project staffs are child safeguard, gender equality, program management, need assessment, training on event management.



CAPACITIES BUILD TRAINING FOR YOUTH:-

Youth will play a major role in the future of the trainees for self-reliance, an improved quality of life. The main objective is to enable rural youth to become economically self-reliant through income generation as small-scale entrepreneurs. The trainer must keep this in mind at all times during the training. All trainees participate in the training by choice and because they believe that the training course will give them the tools necessary for improving their livelihood. It is the responsibility of the trainer to convince trainees that they can do anything and everything they set their minds. In that training discussed

about various types of issues related youth's rights and livelihood, social, political, economical and cultural development. Even trained them about survive for self dependency, self reliance, self esteem and make their good image in society. Trained them through various exercises, group works and aptitude tests. Also discussed about the social, cultural, political and economical participation of youths even skills development among youths to stand as a responsible person in society, taught them about good leadership quality, all these aspects will make them become a well established.





DPO LEADERSHIP TRAINING:-

DPOs believe that people with disability are their own best spokespersons and their role has been and is fundamental for the human rights movement of people with disability. The role of these organizations includes providing a voice of their own, identifying needs, expressing views on priorities, evaluating services and advocating change and public awareness. Indeed, the views of persons with disability were largely filtered through the voices of disability service providers, professionals working in the area of disability and family members. People with disabilities have united in organizations as advocates for their own rights to influence decision-makers in governments and all sectors of society. These organizations are known as disabled people's organization. In that training trained about the process of specific issue on people with disabilities like: certification, pension, bus pass, unique ID,

assistive device, accessibility, inclusive education, reservation in local bodies, employment opportunity etc. Disabled people's organizations have arisen in response to societal barriers that have prevented the equal participation of people with disabilities, and as a reaction against the control of people with disabilities by others. For a long time, people with disabilities have been spoken for by health professionals, family and others without regard for their needs, priorities or choices. People with disabilities are their own best spokespersons and representatives, as they know best their needs and aspirations. Formation D.P.Os federation at panchayat level. Promote and strengthen D.P.Os federation for those poor people with disability who are really need financial support, according to their financial status of families.



BLOCK LEVEL PRI TRAINING:-

Through block level PRI training trained about how to implementation the RPWDs act and policy 2016 for people with disabilities like: certification, pension, linkages with various govt. schemes like: PAY, Unique ID,

Adhar card at panchayat level for people with disabilities. Also trained them about how to formation CBR committee at panchayat level as well as role and responsibility of CBR committee representative disabilities



accessibility facilities in local bodies as well as public places, Even discussed about 2% of reservation should be implementation in local

bodies as members for people with disabilities.



AWARENESS RAISING MEETING:-

According to RPWDs act and policy 2016 organized awareness amongst community people, local leaders, parents and relevant stakeholders, youth leaders, teachers and advocacy and liaising with govt. officers about inclusive development of social, political, economical of person with disabilities for reducing social, political, economical, social stigma, prejudice and policy barriers of people with disabilities. Through meeting with PRI members aware about disabilities rights and entitlement

according to RPWDs act and policy 2016. Panchayati Raj's a system of rural local self-government. It has been established by the acts of the state legislature to build democracy at the grass root level. It is entrusted with rural development and was constitutional. Continuously, mobilize and motivated PRI members about disabilities inclusion in social, political, economical participation of people with disabilities in local bodies.





CBR COMMITTEE:-

Formation and strengthening CBR committees at panchayat level. CBR committees consists of 2 DPOs members, 2 PRI members, 2 ANMs workers, 2 parents, 2 teachers, 2 AWDs, 2 SHGs members for promote people with disabilities with different issue related certification, pension,

employment, livelihood, reservation, scholarship, assistive device, enrollment of people with disabilities at panchayat level. Because through CBR committee people with disabilities directly consult with CBR committee team members for different issue.



WALL WRITING:-

Through wall writing and distribution of IEC materials wrote different slogan and message on many walls about Peoples with Disabilities. And each village wrote very simple word. Because those people who read

that message and slogan they would understand and will share others to related disable people needs and demands for education, health and livelihood.



PANCHAYAT LEVEL DPO MEETING:-

Organized panchayat level DPOs federation meeting for strengthening and improved their leadership quality as well as regular monthly meeting with specific issue on

people with disabilities like: certification, pension, reservation, livelihood and according to RPWDs act and policy 2017.



BLOCK LEVEL DPO MEETING:-

In every block level DPO meeting conducted where DPO leader with DPO member participate. Block level D.P.O meeting Organized at Ramanujnagar, Premnagar, Surajpur, Lakhanpur, Pondariya, Dabhara, Nagari, Udayapur, Mendra, Podi Uproda and Ambikapur blocks. In meeting discussed about Rights of Persons

with Disabilities Rules, 2017, medical certification camp, govt. scheme and reservation, education facilities for Children with disability, certification, pension, ration card, formation CBR committee, group formation, people with disability. 39 Block level meeting has been done in this year.



DISTRICT LEVEL DPO MEETING:-

The Director of MSS Mr. Mehdilal expresses about Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017 implementation procedure with initiative for D.P.Os federation at panchayat level. Promote and strengthen D.P.Os federation for those poor people with

disability who are really need financial support, according to their financial status of families. Major responsibility of Panchayat level D.P.O Federation is, if any people with disability need for financial support according to his/her economic condition in that situation



only the federation will decide who want to need support as a first priority for financial support. Then expressed about **Process of block level D.P.Os formation:** Then expressed about **Process of District D.P.Os formation:** From each block 5 members will

go to District level D.P.Os federation meeting included President, Secretaries with 3 members and for formation of district level D.P.Os federation add 5 members from each block.



STATE LEVEL DPO MEETING:-

The resources person of the meeting was Mr. Mehdi lal explained that according to census data of Govt. of India the total population of people with disabilities is 2.50 corers in India apart from that state govt. data 649000 people with disabilities in 27 district of Chhattisgarh. But still people with disabilities are not getting their basic rights like: food, shelter, health,

education, livelihoods, reservation and employment. Also spoke about social, political, economical condition of people with disabilities is very weak. Outcomes: 100 rupees membership fees for all DPOs members included block, district and state level CVJF leaders. And decided 1 leader should be lead 50 people with disabilities





NATIONAL LEVEL DPO MEETING:-

Organized (BVJF) BahuddeshyViklang Jan Foundation annual meeting 2019 was held on 25th September 2019 to 26th September 2019 at USI Residency New Delhi. The key person of this meeting was Miss. Sara Verges, Mr. Umesh Baurai, Mr. Dinesh Rana, Mr. Bani, Mr. Suresh and Mr. Shisirkant. people with disabilities came

from 18 organization of 11 different state of India for participated in this particular meeting focus on to promote (BVJF) foundation to work for people with disabilities also liaising with govt. department on the basis of people with disabilities needs and demand.

WORLD DISABILITY DAY:-

World Disabled Day is observed every year on 3rd December. Also known as “International Day of Persons with Disabilities”, the theme for 2019 International Day of person with Disabilities is “the Future is Accessible”. The future is accessible means that we must all, together look forward a future where the barriers that stand in people’s way no longer exist. Working toward an accessible future is everyone’s responsibility, as is calling out

barriers wherever they exist and working to overcome them. It is a future that demands that people are not excluded because of their impairments. Before winding up the program assistive device are distributed to person with disability with that small gift to DPO leader for their better achievement in the field. Stitching machine also distributed to the 2 FPO group. MSS best CBR worker are also awarded.



CERTIFICATION OF PEOPLE WITH DISABILITY:-

Every 2nd Wednesday and 4th Saturday of month medical certification boards camp has

been organized in surajpur district hospital with this every Tuesday and Friday of every



week medical certification boards camp been organized in Ambikapur hospital also. Through medical certification camp in both area people with disabilities check and get

their physical treatment. People with disability above 40% of disabilities get their certificate through the support of health care provider by CBR workers.



HOME BASED EDUCATION AND PHYSIOTHERAPY TRAINING:-

Home base education and physiotherapy training are provided to children with disabilities with their parent's permission. Home based education is education provided

at home to the children with disabilities who are unable to move school for their education due to physical and mental impairment.





ASSISTIVE DEVICE:-

Assistive device are distributed to people with disabilities according to their need of device on CM program, World Disability Day and by

Department of Social Welfare. Assistive device distributed such as walker, wheel chair, tricycle, crutches, cane and sticks.

IEC MATERIAL:-

IEC material includes poster, pamphlet, dairy, calendar and booklets which is distributed among the villagers and people with disabilities in the field area of

Margdarshak Seva Sansthan and administrative officers. It also create a awareness about the rights of people with disabilities



PESA (PANCHAYAT EXTENSION SCHEDULED ACT):-

According to Panchayat Extension Scheduled Act and policy 1995 aware about the fifth schedule area as well as of Scheduled Tribes reside in my state process. Panchayat Extension Scheduled Act will reduce alienation in tribal areas as they will have better control over the utilization of public resource. Panchayat Extension Scheduled Act will reduce poverty and outmigration among tribal population as they will have control and management of natural resources will improve their livelihoods and incomes. Panchayat

Extension Scheduled Act will minimize exploitation of tribal population as they will be able to control and manage money lending, consumption and sale of liquor and also village markets. Effective implementation of Panchayat Extension Scheduled Act will check illegal land alienation and also restore unlawfully alienated tribal land. And most importantly Panchayat Extension Scheduled Act will promote cultural heritage through preservation of traditions.

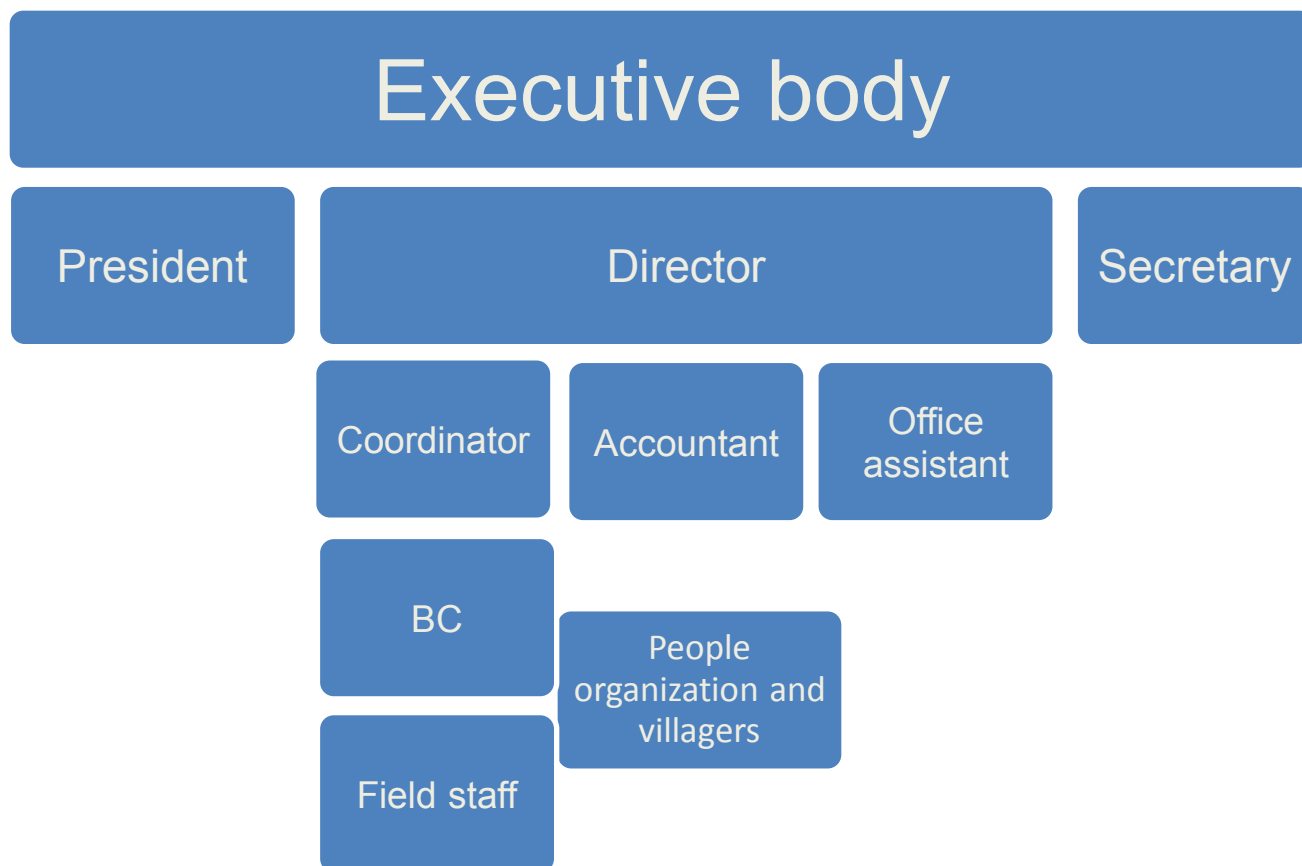

Structure of Governing Board

TRUSTEES

The Trustees of the MSS constitute the governing board of MSS.
